We will make every effort to keep similar height dogs in the same sessions but will make exceptions for handlers who are running more than one dog. At the moment, larger dogs will be running in the morning and smaller dogs will be running in the afternoon, but that will be confirmed based on entries.

PARTICIPANT WAIVER

General Agreement - Not Valid Unless Dated and Signed

I/We, the undersigned, agree that the host business has the right to refuse my entry for causes which Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association, Inc. and Newfoundland Kennel Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the event and the opportunity to have the dog participate.

I/We agree to hold Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association, Inc. and Newfoundland Kennel Club (the

organizer and host organization which it represents including its owner, members), owners of the premises (City of St. John's) upon which the trial is being held, harmless from any claims for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any persons or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near entrances thereto, and I/We personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.

I/We further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from claims of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise from any damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, death or otherwise be caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by negligence of any person, or any cause or causes.

I/We hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage caused by bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting thereof, sustained by any person or persons, including myself/ourselves or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my/our participation in this event, however such injuries, death, or damage to property may be caused and whatever or not the same may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

I/We will follow all safety precautions as identified in the attached safety protocols, and that failure to do so will result in my/our dismissal from the event and all future events while the pandemic measures are in effect.

PROTOCOLS FOR NEWFOUNDLAND ATHLETIC DOG ASSOC., INC. & NEWFOUNDLAND KENNEL CLUB FUN TRIAL JUNE 2021

Please read the following safety protocols for NADA, Inc.'s AAC Trial during social distancing protocols with Covid-19 pandemic. Anyone who violates these safety protocols will be asked to leave without a refund, and may have future registrations refunded/cancelled.

1. The morning/day of the event, all participants must conduct a Covid-19 Screening Assessment (see attached). If they answer yes to any of the questions, they must not attend the event, and should contact 811 for further information for further testing/screening.
2. Please do not arrive in the field before your allotted time, as there may be other individuals working in the ring space prior to your time. This will provide the appropriate buffer and maintain physical distancing.
3. There will be no handouts at the event. All maps or documents will be emailed prior to the event. Participants are responsible for bringing their own copies or to have them electronically with them. Waiver forms must be signed and emailed to the trial secretary prior to the day of the event as there won't be paper waivers.
4. Bring your own chair, shade, crate, water, any snacks (yours or dogs), and training toys. No water/food will be available or shared on site. There will be pylons marking out crating areas for each participant (~15' apart). Please set-up at these locations. During sanctioned trials, these will be around the perimeter of the ring. During training events, they will be along a single side of the ring.

5. All participants must maintain proper social distancing from the host and other participants who are not from the same household or personal bubble.
6. Personal protective equipment (masks/face coverings) must be brought with you, and worn during walk-throughs and briefings (group instructions) when physical distancing might not be guaranteed. PPE is not required while you run your dog inside the ring, but you may use it if you wish. If you require medical exemption, please let the Trial Manager know prior to the event as accommodations will be made to increase physical distancing for you.
7. A hand sanitizing station will be located at the entry/exit gate of the agility ring, accessible to you both in and out of the ring. You must sanitize your hands upon entering the ring, and upon exiting the ring. For your safety, sanitize your hands as the gate will be a common touch point. To maintain physical distancing the gate steward will be stationed 10' away from the entry and will not operate the gate for competitors.
8. For videos, please use a self-standing tripod. No camera/phone tripods may be attached to any equipment or fencing, and other participants may not use your phone to record runs. You may ask someone to record your run on their camera and to forward you the file.
9. In the ring, only you will be permitted to touch your leash, toy (no audible or food dispensing toys and no food is permitted in the ring during trials). If for safety purposes, someone must hold onto the dog, collar or leash, they will try to sanitize their hands beforehand. Lysol spray will be available on the sanitation station if you wish to sanitize the leash/collar afterwards. (Do not spray towards the dog's face.)
10. During trials, the judge, timer, scribe will be in the ring but will all maintain social distancing from each other and from the competitor. If you need to approach them please ensure you wear a mask.
11. Be sure to sanitize your hands before and after adjusting any equipment. For course changes, all individuals in the ring must be wearing face masks as social distancing might not be guaranteed. All equipment will be sanitized at the start and end of the day, and during the lunch break at trials.
12. All dog refuse is to be cleaned and disposed of in the City garbage bin. All garbage is to be similarly disposed of properly. All recycling is to be taken home by the participant who brought the container. Recycling shall not be collected/gathered at these events.
13. In the case of a first aid emergency, there will be disposable PPE (gloves and mask) available to don before assisting the individual. Gloves and disposable masks (not N95) will be available in the First Aid Kit.

This is not meant to be used as a tool to assess your overall health nor does it replace a visit to your primary care physician. If you have seasonal or environmental allergies and they are worse than normal the day of the event, this constitutes "new or worsening" in Question 3.
